

City Administrator's Report
May 4, 2010

A reminder that the Council will be discussing the Fall River Wastewater Regionalization IGA next week at the Committee of the Whole. John Andes from Baker Tilly will review and explain the documents. The Council is asked to thoroughly read the documents as the Council will be asked to approve the IGA and attachments on May 18. The Fall River Village Board will be voting on the matter on May 11.

The city administration is seeking information on additional funding from FEMA for acquisition of property which incurred damage from the 2008 Flood. If there are available funds, the Council will be requested to consider the item in a future workshop.

The City Administrator attended the 2010 WERC Seminar last week. Very pertinent information was received concerning recent developments in labor law concerning furloughs, contract bargaining language, discipline letters, and arbitration cases decisions.

The City hosted a successful Arbor Day Program in Avalon Park last Friday. Thanks to the Department of Public Works, Steve Sobiek and other city officials and the general public, including students and teachers from the Columbus School District, for their attendance and participation.

The EOC administrator has established the first Wednesday of each month in the EOC office beginning at 2pm for regular meetings. As we just met last week, the next meeting will be June 2nd.

The City Attorney and City Administrator will be meeting next week to discuss a process for the solicitation of legal services for the City after Mr. Leuder's elected term expires next April.
