Congratulations to the Mayor and City Council on accepting the IGA with the Village of Fall River for Wastewater Regionalization. There will a ceremony signing of the contracts within the next two weeks, time and place to be determined.

Work continues on the plans and specifications for bidding purposes for the Udey Dam.

The City has received a correspondence from the Wisconsin Academy regarding sanitary sewer service. The city administration has responded that the subject can be broached after all of the contracts and paperwork is executed between the City and Fall River.

The Community Development Authority hosted a very successful CDA 2010 Annual Business Awards and Luncheon. Congresswoman Tammy Baldwin was the guest speaker and a gracious thank you is extended on behalf of the City of Columbus for her participation.
