

**COLUMBUS COMMON COUNCIL – REGULAR MEETING  
COLUMBUS CITY HALL  
TUESDAY, JUNE 1, 2010 – 6:30 PM**

The Columbus Common Council held a regular meeting at 6:30 pm on Tuesday June 1, 2010 at Columbus City Hall. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Link and notice of open meeting was noted as posted. Present: Mayor Link, Council members Bomkamp, Bruns, Perkins, Sneath and Walker, City Attorney Lueders, City Administrator Kraemer, City Clerk Donahue, City Treasurer Green, interested citizens and the media. Excused Schumann. Motion by Sneath second by Bruns to approve the agenda with Item # 3 New Business, 2010 Fire Department Travel Policy, deleted. Motion carried voice vote.

Ed Schellin, representing the 'Parents Who Host Lose the Most' program, presented a proclamation and asked the Council to endorse the proclamation. Mayor Link read the proclamation for the record.

Mayor Link made a presentation of a plaque to Mark A. Jansen, Columbus School District Administrator, for his years of service with the Columbus School District upon his retirement this June. Jansen thanked the Council for the recognition and for the continued cooperation of the Council with the school district.

Administrator Kraemer made a presentation of a plaque to Lana Platz for 20 years of service to the City as Deputy Clerk. Ms. Platz thanked Mayor Link and Kraemer and stated she looks forward to many more years.

Administrator Kraemer read a letter from the Wisconsin Treasurers Association of Wisconsin acknowledging City Treasurer Green for her re-certification with the association.

Mayor Link read the items on the Consent Agenda. No items were asked to be removed from the Consent Agenda. Motion by Bruns second by Perkins to approve the Consent Agenda as read. Motion carried voice vote.

A proclamation entitled 'Supporting the Designation of the first week in June as "National Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation and Automated External Defibrillator Awareness Week"' was read in its entirety by Clerk Donahue.

Motion by Sneath second by Bomkamp to adopt Resolution #11-10 "Resolution in Support of the Greater Columbus Energy Task Force". Motion carried 5-0 on a roll call vote with Bomkamp, Bruns, Perkins, Sneath and Walker voting 'Yes'.

Motion by Bruns second by Walker to approve the appointment of Darrell Augustine to Board of Review, term to expire in 2015. Motion carried 4-1 on a roll call vote with Bruns, Perkins, Sneath and Walker voting 'Yes' and Bomkamp voting 'No'.

Administrator Kraemer updated the Council on his activities since the last meeting, including a new construction schedule for the Udey Dam will be available this week, the municipal audit will be reviewed at the next committee of the whole, and continues to work with Moraine Park Technical College.
