

**COLUMBUS COMMON COUNCIL – COMMITTEE OF THE WHOLE
WORK SESSION – 2011 BUDGETS
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2010 – 8:55 PM

The Columbus Common Council met as a committee of the whole on Tuesday November 9, 2010 at 8:55 p.m. at Columbus City Hall. The meeting was called to order by Council President Perkins and notice of open meeting was noted as posted. Present: Mayor Link, Council members Bomkamp, Perkins, Schumann, Sneath and Walker, City Administrator Kraemer, City Clerk Donahue, Chief Meister, interested citizens and the media. Excused: Bruns.

Council President Perkins asked for comments from the Council on the proposed 2011 budgets for all city funds. Kraemer began with a discussion of the Police Department and asked the Council for direction on an additional lieutenant and squad car replacement. Consensus was to leave the squad in, and leave the additional lieutenant out the 2011 budget.

Discussion continued on the department budgets, the general fund and the other funds not supported by the tax levy. The budget resolution will be prepared with the numbers as they stand after this meeting and will be on the agenda November 16, 2010 for approval.
