MINUTES:

LAWN & TREES:

Public Works Director Davis Clark reported all dandelion spraying completed. Coughlin Lawn mowing contract is a 2 year contract. This year's mowing cost \$1,646.64 per mowing. Figuring 26 mowing per year, may change due to growing season.

STONE REPAIR FOR 2018:

Sgt. Darrell Stibb of the Correctional Center was contacted and will be here: April 27, April 30, May 1-2-3, work on headstones. Mike and Vic Hanousek (Wisconsin Cemetery Services) will be back to help and work with the correctional guys. Davis Clark said the City would help providing supplies and materials for the workers. Need to document the repair work each season, make a list of each stone, section, lot, and name with pictures. We will continue where we left off last year. A Committee consisting of Dave Roelke, John Van Roo, Jim Kluetzman, Mike Hanousek and Davis Clark will handle this project.

COMPUTER PROGRAM UP DATE:

Discussion of putting cemetery records on web for public usage. There should be more than one person assigned to enter data. Davis Clark will check what we need.

Beth Altschwager made a motion to go ahead and bring our cemetery records up to date, second by Clara Sennhenn, carried by voice vote. Gloria Moldscheck will get the exact figures.
