

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING
HILLSIDE CEMETERY ASSOCIATION
MONDAY, AUGUST 21, 2023, AT 6:35 PM
COLUMBUS COMMUNITY CENTER

The special meeting of Hillside Cemetery was called to order by President John Marks at 6:35 pm. at the Columbus Community Center to revise and vote on the Rules and Regulations and Bylaws of the Hillside Cemetery on Monday, August 21, 2023.

Those Present were John Marks, President, Deb Moungey, Secretary/ Treasurer, Jim Klutzman, Dave Roelke, Shirley Banetske, Clara Sennhenn, Beth Altschwager.

Absent with an excuse were Robert Link, Joyce Shepard, and Evelyn McNulty.

Absent without an excuse was Ian Gray.

Visitor was Darlene Marks.

The reading of the new Rules and Regulations and Bylaws began with each page, discussing the red highlighted changes. Pages 1 through 10 were accepted and there was no discussion.

Page 11 Monuments and Markers was discussed as some problems existed as to the amount of space available for foundations with the 12 inches on each end. It was discussed to have the spaces 6 inches all around to make things simpler. After much discussion a compromise was set at 6 inches front and back and 8 inches on each end throughout the whole cemetery.

Motion by Dave Roelke and seconded by Jim Klutzman that: All monuments will have a 6 inch space front and back and an 8 inch space on each end of the foundation. The vote was 4 in favor and 3 opposed. Motion carried.

The rest of page 11 was accepted and we continued to go through the Rules and Regulations without any other objections.

A motion was made by Shirley Benetske and seconded by Clara Sennhenn to approve the new Rules and Regulations and Bylaws. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion to adjourn was made by Jim Klutzman and seconded by Beth Altschwager. Motion carried unanimously.
